Vendor and Exhibitor Roll Out Information

1. No engine may start until the roll-up door has been opened – (Any vehicle that does is in violation of current Fire Marshall regulations and is chancing a monetary fine.)
2. All vehicles that can drive out under their own power will be the first to leave.
3. Any vehicles that can be pushed and loaded onto trailers outside will be the next to roll out.
4. If you have a vehicle or trailer outside that you would like to bring in the building this will be allowed **ONLY AFTER** steps 2 and 3 have been completed **DO NOT TRY TO GET IN THE BUILDING OR BLOCK THE RAMP AT ANYTIME. PACK UP WHAT YOU CAN UNTIL WE GIVE THE OK FOR VEHICLES TO ENTER THE BUILDING. WE HIGHLY SUGGEST THAT YOU HAVE EVERYTHING BROKEN DOWN AND READY TO BE LOADED INTO YOUR VEHICLE OR TRAILER BEFORE BRINGING YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE BUILDING.**
5. **WHEN BRINGING IN YOUR VEHICLE DO NOT JAM UP THE ROWS AND BACK ENTRANCES. THE BUILDING IS SET UP IN ROWS. PLEASE DO NOT PARK SIDWAYS IN A ROW ALL YOU WILL BE DOING IS JAMMING EVERYONE ELSE UP. ALSO BE SURE TO SHUT OFF YOUR SUPPORT VEHICLE WHEN LOADING – DO NOT LEAVE IT RUNNING INSIDE THE BUILDING.**

Take your time there is no rush – we know it has been a long weekend for everyone but giving yourself a few deep breaths and an extra 10-15 minutes will make for an easier roll out and more enjoyable conclusion to a long weekend.
